What does it cost?

All our drivers are volunteers and give their time without being paid. However, passengers pay a mileage charge to help cover the driver's fuel cost. In addition passengers meet the cost of any car parking or congestion charges. Payment is made to the driver at the time of the journey.

What journeys can we help with?

We can take you to appointments at:

We can also take you to visit relatives in hospitals and nursing homes.

However, as all our drivers are volunteers, we ask passengers to be considerate and not ask them to make detours or undertake shopping trips.

How does it work?

It is very simple. Once you have registered you ring our dedicated phone line to book your journey. We then find a driver who will ring you to confirm details.

How do I join?

To register with the service, telephone 01280 841099 and we will send you the necessary forms. There is an annual registration fee.

How much notice do you require to find me a volunteer driver?

Tell us as soon as you have got your appointment by ringing 01280 841099. However, we must receive at least three working days notice of your appointment.

We cannot guarantee that every request for a journey will be met – although given the correct amount of notice it is rare that we cannot help.
